# Weather & Clothing

Weather wise we have had a good start to the term and have been able to explore and access the whole garden. Just a reminder our woodland garden has very rough terrain in places with lots of tripping hazards so firm footwear is a must. All children should by now have a pair of named wellies at school so that they are ready for the inevitable puddles and mud! Don't forget if children come in wellies they must have indoor shoes to change into.

As the weather changes please make sure children are wearing warm, waterproof clothing as we are very much an outdoor school and will go out in most weathers, so it is important that the children are dressed appropriately and have a coat with them each day.

Please make sure they also have lots of spare tops, bottoms, pants and socks in their drawstring change bag (there isn't room on the pegs for bulky ruck sacks).
