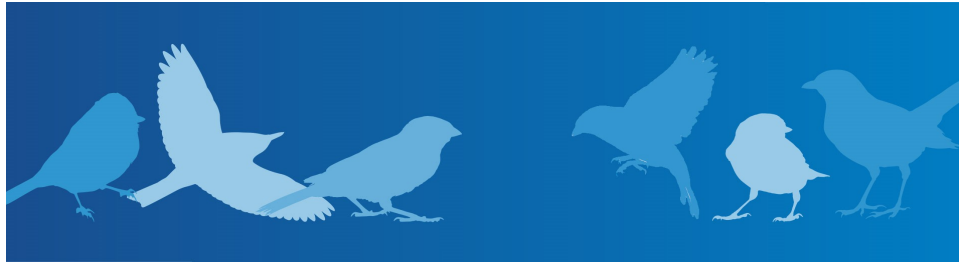


Creative Choices!
